Thank you to all who attended the LFHA meeting for the Greenwood Counts Community Consortium.

Below is a summary of each portion of our meeting with a direct link to the video recording for that portion:

- Andrea White welcomed the LFHA Members and initiated introductions and organization updates. In attendance were, Bryan Yebba, Britney Mazyck, Hanna Sharif-Kazemi, Courtney Watson, Andrew White, Andria Wendell, Gabrielle Dilka, Anetra Hardy, Trish Buis, April Ouzts, Ashley Redfern, Patsy Garcia, Will Metts, Anetra Hardy, and Justo Chalaire.
 - **Organization Updates**
- Bryan Yebba shared information on a local seed library initiative.
- Anetra Hardy shared that there are nonprofits that will assist folks who are justice involved.

Drug Policy Alliance

Hanna gave an introduction to the Drug Policy Alliance, who they are and what they do.
Their current focus is repealing the lifetime ban on individuals convicted of a drug felony
from being eligible to receive SNAP assistance using the Farm Bill as the vehicle. She
provided history on this ban. South Carolina is the only state with a total SNAP ban. She
provided background on the advocacy with a highlight that the biden-harris administration
is giving focus to this ban. She then gave action items on how our alliance could get
involved.

LFHA Updates

- Justo shared that our \$25,000 LFHA CDG Budget has been signed and funds are ready
 to be utilized. He also shared that Greenwood Food Resource Map on
 lakelandscounts.org has been added to a flyer in partnership with DHEC. A goal of 1000
 copies to be distributed by January was set and we distributed 285. We currently have
 221 page views on the resource guide.
- Justo shared that the GC3 Impact Tracker is available and LFHA members have began
 including their organizational impact. This will show a collective effort to reduce food
 insecurity and build public will to support our work. Some alliance members still need to
 add updates.
- Just mentioned our food assessment is complete. The GC3 Data team is currently
 working on a full report representing insights from the GC3 Community Survey and
 listening sessions.

Action items that came from the meeting:

- Data and Analytics team to continue to analyze and generate a food insecurity report from listening sessions and the GC3 Community Survey.

- GC3 Members to advertise the Food and Hunger Alliance and invite one member to the group.
