• Welcome and Introductions:

• Organization Updates:

• Kathy Cinnamond is leading the mental health first aid training for this community. Community wide training in English 4/24 and Spanish training on 5/8 at United Way. We do not have a firm time, but it is an 8-hour training. Nita suggested AHEC could possibly provide CEUs. Kathy has already reached out to Lauren Taylor at Upstate AHEC. She has created an Eventbrite link for the training, and it is free. She will also provide flyers. Justo will send the registration link to the group.

• ACE's Training:

- Justo introduced the details for the upcoming ACEs training on 4/4/24. Children's Trust will be hosting the training. Justo discussed the importance of understanding ACEs and those being the root cause of many issues.
- The training will be at Piedmont Technical College. Educators, churches and industry are the target audiences. It will be a hybrid meeting and can hold up to 100 participants. Dana Powell with Children's Trust will facilitate.
- Each training will last one hour. After, we will host listening sessions to gauge individual perspectives on barriers to mental health in the community. This will help inform next steps. Lucila Beaton, Ashlee Redfern, Ebony Burgess, and Kayla Livingston will be the in-person facilitators.

- The group was asked for feedback on the structure of the listening sessions, proposing it be broken out by sectors. The concern is some groups may have more than others, so a suggestion was to have them all together. Possibly have people self-select what group they want.
- Michael suggested using Menti-meter. We could use both post its and Mentimeter to assure everyone is comfortable if they are unfamiliar with using the virtual option. The responses received are what we will present in May.
- There will be two options for virtual training for facilitators on 2/29 2-4 or 3/1 9:30-2
- A suggestion was made to make sure participants know the "why" of this project.
